We can use **almost all books** for children and adolescents, aside from English and Maths textbooks and foreign language books.

We provide 500 books to each primary school and 500-1,000 to each high school. We aim to provide a core collection to each school. We have difficulty filling some non-fiction aspects of this core collection, and **ask whether you could consider donating books in some or all of these specific categories:**

- Class readers

 - Encyclopaedia set – 1985 or more recent
 - Atlas
 - Dictionary
 - Guinness Book of Records
 - Time Life Books (if available)

 - Dinosaurs
 - Prehistory of man
 - Captain Cook / Early Australian settlement etc
 - Book on South Pacific (particularly PNG)
 - Nature book – fishes/coral reef
 - Nature/Ecology book – forests
 - Other nature books – snakes crocodiles etc etc
 - Astronomy
 - Spaceflight
 - Aeroplanes
 - “How things work” books
 - Human body
 - Books on buildings/industry/energy and similar topics
 - World War 2
 - Cars and car repairs
 - Books on other countries
 - Rugby league, athletics, volleyball, basketball or martial arts (the most popular sports)
 - also very useful: books on carpentry, basic agriculture skills, sewing and handicrafts, reproductive health, first aid, health and nutrition
- of all fiction groups, we have most trouble getting fiction suitable for teenagers

But all fiction and non-fiction books for children or adolescents, except English and Maths textbooks and foreign language books, are useful. Plus we can also use any educational CD-ROMs, and science, art, music and sport equipment, and library shelves.
